

I'll Be There

Goddard is opening the doors of the church for the 8:30 AM worship service on Sunday, October 4, 2020 which is World Communion Sunday. The 10:50 AM service will be online only.

Please call the church office at 479.785.1415 to let us know that you are coming to the 8:30 AM service. The last day to call will be on Thursday prior to the Sunday service. The doors of the church will open at 8:00 AM on Sunday. Your health and safety are our #1 priority. If you are sick, please do not come to church.

Seating is limited. Families will be seated together. Individuals will be seated six feet apart to follow CDC guidelines. The wearing of masks is mandatory. Please do not come to church if you have recently traveled outside of the country or have traveled to a COVID-19 hotspot within the United States.

Here are some things you need to know:

- **Wear a face mask.** We will have masks available if you forget yours.
- Your **temperature** will be taken before you enter the church. **Anyone with a fever will not be allowed inside the building.**
- Before entering the building, you will sign an **“Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19” form.**
- Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will be available at the entrance to the church and sanctuary.
- There will be touch less entry and exit to/from the building.
- The hallway, sanctuary, and restrooms will be sanitized prior to the service. **We cannot promise a virus-free space.**
- Once you enter the building, you will notice that the hallway is narrowed to accommodate social distancing while on your way to the sanctuary.
- If you need to visit the restroom, please social distance and remember to **wash your hands.** We will need to limit the number of persons in the restroom at any given time.
- There will be two helpers at the sanctuary door handing out prepackaged Communion elements (juice and wafers).
- There will be offering plates at the sanctuary door. Please place your offerings there on your way in or out of the sanctuary.
- **There will be special seating arrangements once you enter the sanctuary. Let the usher guide you to your seat. Families will be allowed to sit together.**
- **During the singing of the congregational songs, please leave your mask “on”.**

- When it is time for Communion, you may remove your face mask. **You will not come up to the Communion rail.**
- After taking the elements, please put your face mask back on. Hold on to the element packaging. You will discard empty packaging as you leave the sanctuary.
- After the service, an usher will guide you to the main hallway. Remember to social distance as you make your way to the exit. **Your face mask is to remain on until you leave the building.**
- We will not be recycling the bulletins. As you leave the sanctuary, please discard the bulletin and the element packaging in the waste receptacle that is located near the entrance to the sanctuary.
- Sunday school, Youth and Children's Sunday school **will not** be held until further notice.
- Coffee and snacks will not be allowed inside the building at this time.
- There **will not** be an area set aside inside or outside the building for visiting with friends prior to or after the service.
